- The selection of textbooks shall be completed according to the laws and policies required by the
- 5 State of Tennessee and the State Textbook Commission. The responsibility for textbook
- 6 selection rests with the local textbook selection committees subject to approval by the Board.¹
- 7 The director of schools shall establish a procedure for providing the citizens of the community an opportunity to examine proposed textbooks prior to their final adoption, 2 including public notice 8

9 of time and location at which textbooks may be examined.

The materials clerk shall be designated by the Board to be responsible for the purchase and distribution of textbooks in each school. The principal shall be responsible for seeing that each student receives the required textbooks at no cost to the student.³

CARE OF TEXTBOOKS

- Textbooks are property of the Board and shall be returned at the end of the school year, upon
- 20 completion of the course or upon withdrawal from a course or school. Parents are to sign an agreement stating they will be responsible for the textbooks received and used by their children. 21
- 22 The condition of each book and a book number shall be recorded by the teacher issuing it at the
- beginning of each year. Textbook charge records shall be completed at the end of each year 23
- 24 verifying the number of books assigned to each teacher as well as the condition of each book.
- Any book found not to be substantially complete for the following year shall be subject to 25 26

reimbursement cost from the student to whom it was assigned.
