The decision of Top Ten or Top Ten percent will be made at the 11 beginning of the graduating student cohort entering the Freshman year. Valedictorians and 12 13 Salutatorians will be determined by the long average as well. 14 WEAKLEY SCHOLARS 15 16 A student graduates as a Weakley Scholar if their academic performance meets the following threshold. 17 (Weighted GPA x 250) + (ACT Superscore x 27.778) = 1700 or higher, no rounding, students 18 19 must have an ACT score of 21 or higher. 20 SCHOOL LEVEL SCHOLARS (Charger Scholars, Bulldog Scholars, Jacket Scholars, 21 Lion Scholars) 22 A student graduates as a School Level Scholar if their academic performance meets the 23 following threshold. 24 (Weighted GPA x 250) + (ACT Superscore x 27.778) = 1550, no rounding, students must have 25 an ACT score of 21 or higher. 26 27 The February national test date of a student's graduation year will be the last time an ACT score 28 can count toward Weakley or School Level Scholar distinctions. 29 30 31 32 33
