TOP TEN AND VALEDICTORIANS/SALUTATORIANS

Students must be enrolled and complete all of the last two (2) years, the 11th and 12th grades, at Weakley County high schools in order to be eligible for the Top Ten.

All numeric grades earned in grades 9, 10, 11, and 12 will be counted toward the grade point average and the rank in class.

Top Ten students (or Top Ten percent at the discretion of the Principal) will be determined by using the long average. The decision of Top Ten or Top Ten percent will be made at the beginning of the graduating student cohort entering the Freshman year. Valedictorians and Salutatorians will be determined by the long average as well.

WEAKLEY SCHOLARS

A student graduates as a Weakley Scholar if their academic performance meets the following threshold.

$(\text{Weighted GPA} \times 250) + (\text{ACT Superscore} \times 27.778) = 1700$ or higher, no rounding, students must have an ACT score of 21 or higher.

SCHOOL LEVEL SCHOLARS (Charger Scholars, Bulldog Scholars, Jacket Scholars, Lion Scholars)

A student graduates as a School Level Scholar if their academic performance meets the following threshold.

$(\text{Weighted GPA} \times 250) + (\text{ACT Superscore} \times 27.778) = 1550$, no rounding, students must have an ACT score of 21 or higher.

The February national test date of a student's graduation year will be the last time an ACT score can count toward Weakley or School Level Scholar distinctions.
