"Workplace" shall 4 include any school building or any school premises; any school-owned or any other school-5 6 approved vehicle used to transport students to and from school or school activities; and off-7 school property during any school-sponsored or school-approved activity, event, or function. 8 9 As a condition of employment, each employee shall notify his/her supervisor of his/her conviction on any criminal drug statute for violation occurring in the workplace as defined above 10 no later than five (5) days after conviction. 11 12 Any employee who violates the terms of this policy shall be suspended and shall be subject to 13

The Director of Schools shall be responsible for providing a copy of this policy to all school system employees.²
